- D. Removal of death's sting
 - **1 Corinthians 15:54-57 (NIV)** 54 When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory." 55 "Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?"

II. To provide the necessary solution D. Removal of death's sting
